

OPPOSE HB 1634

More Congestion, Damaged Roads, Higher Costs for Consumers

HB 1634 would force the Illinois EPA to adopt emission regulations set by the state of California, mandating the sale of heavier, more expensive trucks. In addition, Illinois would be surrendering their environmental regulation to an unelected agency nearly 2,000 miles away.

HB 1634 WILL CREATE MORE CONGESTION: INCLUDING 34% MORE TRUCKS ON OUR ROADS

- Electric Trucks that are mandated by HB 1634 cannot carry as much as traditional trucks.
- HB 1634 would require 34% more trucks on our congested roadways to deliver the same amount of goods that traditional trucks deliver. *
- Chicago already has the third highest congestion costs nationally, costing citizens \$2.5 billion per year.

HB 1634 WILL DAMAGE ROADS

- Electric Trucks are much heavier and will do more damage to our state and local roads than traditional trucks.
- Heavy Duty Electric Trucks weigh over 50% more than their diesel equivalent. *

HB 1634 WILL COST CONSUMERS MORE

- A new, electric semi-truck costs upwards of \$480,000, compared to \$180,000 to \$200,000 for a new, traditional truck; and the cost of a charger is \$112,000.
- The cost to operate an electric truck is nearly double the cost to operate a traditional truck. *
- Higher transportation costs mean higher costs for consumers.
